School Response to Radicalisation Initiative (PREVENT)

The School has a clear and well stated ethos which includes a commitment to British Values. This is available on the School Website, is in the front of the school and is discussed with the children.

The Head Teacher has received PREVENT training and has shared this with Staff and Governors. As a result, the school has a clear response to the PREVENT Duty.

The School has a clear Child Protection and Safe Guarding Policy. This is reviewed each year. This is based on Cambridgeshire L.A. Policy and is available on the School Website. The Policy has been written and is used to keep the children of our community safe and reflects our context. The School works to encourage positive attitudes in all children; it promotes tolerance and is clear about appropriate behaviour and positive values. All members of staff are aware of Safe Guarding Procedures, including how to log concerns.

The School has open and positive relationships with the community it serves.

The School shares a responsibility in ensuring pupils are safe on line. As part of lessons, the PSHE Scheme of work and school assemblies/themes, the children are taught about how to be knowledgeable, confident and resilient young people. This includes safe and appropriate use of technologies and social media. Information and advice is shared with parents and families.
